CALL TO ORDER – The meeting was called to order at 12:03 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – The February 3rd, 2025, Airport Advisory Board meeting minutes were approved as presented.

RECONSTRUCTION OF THE PARTIAL PARALLEL TAXIWAY TO RUNWAY 04/22 - Bill and Brian gave an update on the project. The project had two contractors that presented bids. Emery Sapp & Sons had the low bid which was within 10% of the engineer's estimate. In the next few weeks, we will receive information on FAA available funds and then go to City Commission for project approval.

STATE OF KANSAS AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (KAIP) – Bill and Brian gave information on an Airport grant through the State of Kansas Airport Improvement Program (KAIP) \$81,000 for a focused Airport Layout Plan update. Funding will be available after July 1st, 2025.

Geoffrey Hines asked about the Runway 17-35 crack sealing project. Bill confirmed the project had been completed full length and width.

Josh Luken asked about the location of the airport security cameras. Bill confirmed one is located on the east side of the terminal building looking at the main entrance gate and one is located inside the terminal building lobby. Jay Byers talked about possibly adding new security cameras if there was a need.
